






- ☐ Poverty is a **vicious circle**. It is about more than shortage of money
- Poverty **reduces opportunities**, including the opportunity to do well at school or work and to get a good job
- Poverty generates **multiple disadvantages** through unemployment, low income, low attainment, poor housing, inadequate health care and barriers to lifelong learning, culture and of course life choices
- Poverty has a harmful effect on many aspects of people's lives, especially **physical and mental health**. People on the lowest incomes are twice as likely as those in the richest 40% to be experiencing anxiety and depression

Action For Sport – The importance of the environment ..

School – One In a Million, Bradford Time – 6 Months



35% of the school have been supported by Action For Sport
75% of Pupil Premium students have received support
85% of students in receipt of and EHCP have received support
100% of Children Looked After have received support
100% of students who are Refugee/Asylum seekers have received support

20% of those receiving support have increased their attendance at school and participation in PE and after school clubs

The schools Persistent Absence rate has reduced by 1.8% following our targeted work with these students
